

Bobbie Householder Scholarship

Mr. Gary Householder, faculty member at Presentation Academy, established the Bobbie Householder Scholarship in memory of his mother. Mrs. Householder was a civic leader and dedicated community volunteer in Blount County, Tennessee. This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a current Presentation freshman and will be applied to the tuition for their sophomore year. A committee of faculty and staff of Presentation Academy will review all applications and make the final selection. The following criteria will be considered for evaluation.

Community Involvement and Service	40%
Leadership	30%
Academics	20%
Extra-Curricular	10%
