

Bobbie Householder Scholarship

Mr. Gary Householder, faculty member at Presentation Academy, established the Bobbie Householder Scholarship in memory of his mother. Mrs. Householder was a civic leader and dedicated community volunteer in Blount County, Tennessee. This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a current Presentation sophomore and will be applied to the tuition for their junior year. A committee of faculty and staff of Presentation Academy will review all applications and make the final selection. The following criteria will be considered for evaluation.

Community Involvement	40%
Leadership	30%
Academics	20%
Extra-Curricular	10%

On a separate sheet of paper, please answer the following three questions in paragraph format. No more than one page per answer. (Your answers must be double-spaced). Please submit a resume along with your answers.

1. You have completed community service hours as a prerequisite for graduation. What one or two significant activities did you participate in and what did you accomplish? What impact did this have on your understanding of citizenship and the importance of serving others?
2. You have been involved in many leadership development activities in your two years at Presentation. What do you feel are two key traits of being an effective leader? Explain how you demonstrate these traits.
3. In your involvement in extra-curricular activities, how have you demonstrated self-discipline in achieving an acceptable balance among academics, social, and extra-curricular priorities?

Please submit all required information to Mrs. Wardrip no later than Friday, March 19, 2010. **No late applications will be accepted.** The scholarship recipient will be notified during the week of May 6th and recognized at Awards Day.
