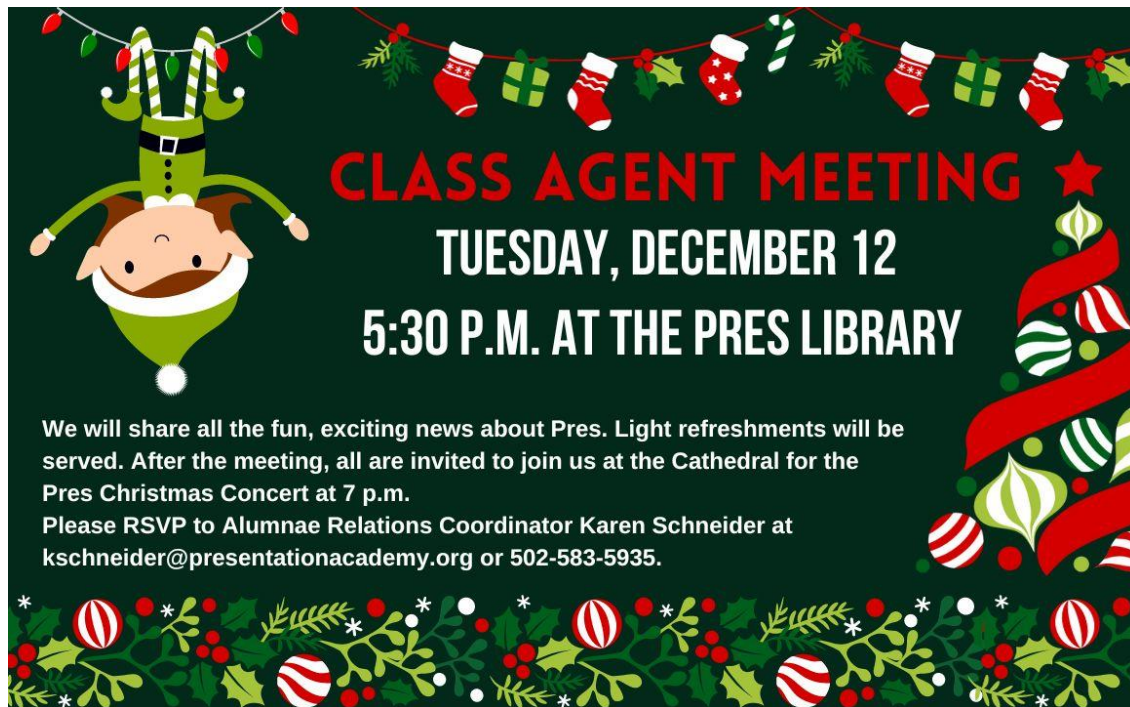

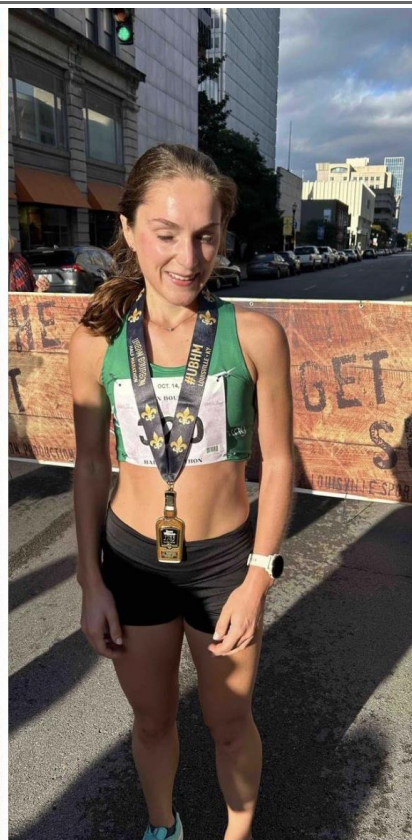

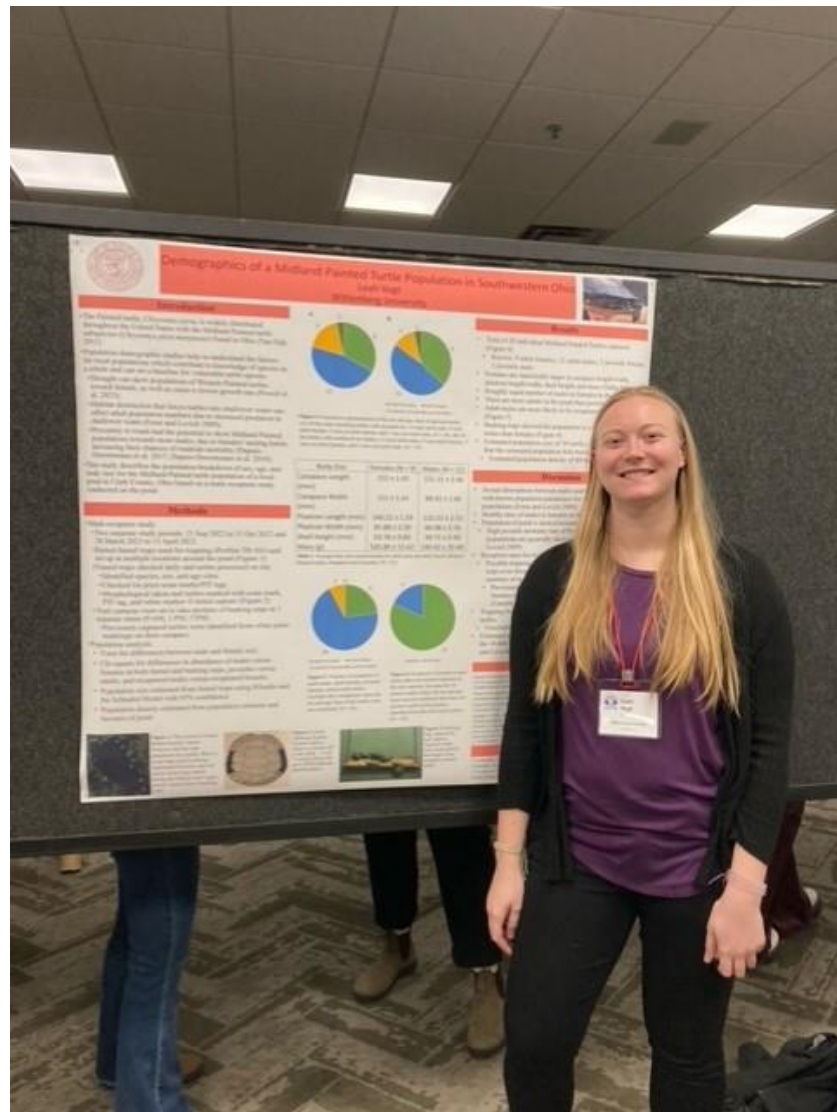


Gosser wins Urban Bourbon
