FRESHMAN SERVICE PROGRAM GUIDELINES 2022-2023**

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*The service program is based on the mission of Catherine Spalding to work for justice in solidarity with oppressed peoples, especially the economically poor and women, and to take care of the earth.*

**Freshman Service Requirements:**

- **10 hours** of indirect service. Indirect Service includes helping neighbors, parish or church events (including summer Bible schools and retreats), coaching, walking or raising money for fundraisers, Open House, phonathons, working with animals, etc.
- All hours must be entered, along with photographs, and verified on MobileServe
- Students may start service June 1, 2022 and all hours are due by April 28, 2023.
- Failure to complete the hours before the end of May 2023 will result in an F for second semester and the student will need to complete 10 additional hours during the summer before returning sophomore year.
- Theology service hours cannot be shared with other service requirements (i.e. KYA, NHS, etc.).
- APPROVED placements focus on the Corporal Works of Mercy of feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, clothing the naked, visiting the imprisoned, sheltering the homeless, visiting the sick, and burying the dead include the following:
